

BIBLICAL AUTHORITY IN MATTERS OF FAITH AND CONDUCT



October 4 and November 8, 2014

Lutherans maintain that the Bible is the Word of God and that it is their only authoritative norm for matters of faith and conduct. But what do we do when *everyone* seems to quote the Bible and claim that God is on their side? A few years ago, Mark Allan Powell produced a series of videos dealing with a Lutheran understanding of scripture and now, in this course, he will give us an opportunity to engage with him personally concerning important questions and issues that the widely viewed videos have raised. We will consider, first, what Lutherans mean when they say the Bible is "the word of God." Then, we will look specifically at how the Bible can serve as an authoritative guide for knowing right from wrong. Finally, Powell will focus on the teaching of Jesus in the Gospel of Matthew to illustrate how timeless biblical teaching can be applied to ever-changing circumstances. According to Jesus, devout believers can get moral judgments wrong *either* by being too "liberal" (permissive with regard to modern society) or by being too "conservative" (strict and literal in their interpretation of scripture). Fortunately, Jesus offers some basic guidelines that help people of all perspectives to discern the will of God in the writings of scripture.

This course consists of 2 Saturday classes, October 4 and November 8 (9 a.m.-4 p.m.) plus 5 evening sessions of 2 hours each. The dates and location for small groups will be decided between the small group participants. The registration fee, which covers the course, lunch and breaks, is \$175 per person. The Rev. Dr. Mark Allan Powell will be LIVE at Grace, Waynesboro and it will be "same time" Skype at First, Norfolk and Ebenezer, Marion!



The Rev. Dr. Mark Allan Powell is Professor of New Testament at Trinity Lutheran Seminary and an internationally known biblical scholar. He is editor of the *HarperCollins Bible Dictionary* and author of more than 30 books on the Bible and religion, including the widely used textbook, *Reading the New Testament* (Baker Academic). He has also written in the areas of spiritual formation (*Loving Jesus*), stewardship (*Giving To God*), and homiletics (*What Do They Hear?: Bridging the Gap between Pulpit and Pew*). Powell has taught at seminaries in Estonia, Russia, and Tanzania and is one of the editors of the *Lutheran Study Bible* (Augsburg Fortress).

The primary "textbook" for this course will be the DVD video series, "How Lutherans Understand the Bible" by Mark Allen Powell. Participants will have the option of purchasing the DVD video series but it is not required. Each small group will be provided with the DVD video series to use during their group sessions. Participants will be provided with the transcripts of what is presented on these videos.
