


Crossword Puzzle

Many of us celebrate special occasions by eating cake. What is your favorite kind of cake? Suppose we were to make a chocolate cake. To begin we would need to have a recipe and gather all the ingredients together.

Do you know what ingredients we would put into the bowl to make a chocolate cake? We would need flour, chocolate (cocoa powder), and sugar. We would need baking powder to make it rise and vanilla to give it flavor. We would also need milk, oil, and eggs. (You could actually pre-measure ingredients, arrange on tray, and blend ingredients together if situation permits.)

What happens when we blend all of these individual ingredients together and bake them? WE HAVE CAKE!!!!

Thinking about baking a cake helps us understand the idea of unity. Before Jesus left to go to heaven he prayed and he asked God to give people the love that God had given him so that we could all be blended together to become one.
