


Crossword Puzzle

Lord, we thank you for this family table, and for food that feeds us all. Amen.

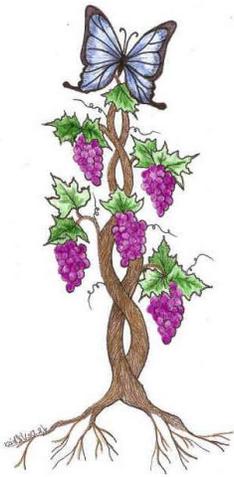
October Memory Verse: Ephesians 2:8 For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith-- and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God.

Faith is like a muscle, if you exercise your faith every day, it will become stronger. We are sometimes very quick to say that we have faith in God. We say that we believe that God can do anything, but then we act as if everything depends on us and that we can do everything by ourselves.
