


Crossword Puzzle

First Sunday of Christmas

Good morning friends! Have any of you seen one of these before? What is it? (allow for answers). Yes! It's a maze. Pretty Ah-mazing, right?! What do you do with a maze? You have to figure out how to get from start to finish without running into the obstacles. What happens if you run into one of those road blocks? (allow for answers) Well, we could turn around, or use our eraser, right? So, no big deal! We get to have fun with figuring out the right way to get to the finish line.

In our gospel lesson from Matthew, we hear that Joseph and Mary are in a bit of a scary maze situation themselves. They aren't really sure of the right way to turn, but if they go the wrong way, the evil king, Herod will kill them. But...God steps in like God always does and tells Mary and Joseph exactly where to turn, pointing them in the exact direction they should go so that their family will be safe.
