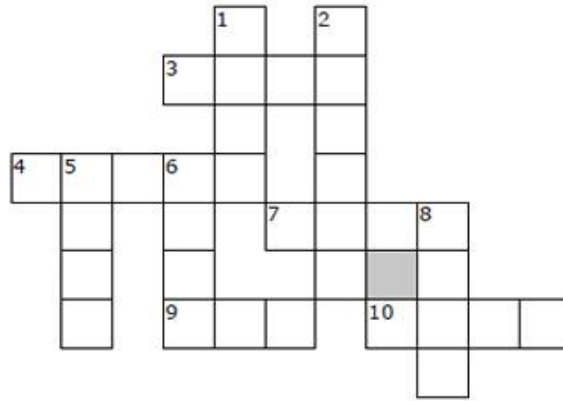


Crossword Puzzle

Third Sunday in Advent

Good morning friends! Is it Christmas yet? NO! We are still waiting. Today, is our third Sunday in Advent and we light our pink candle which represents joy. What are some things that bring you joy? (allow for answers)

In our gospel this morning from Matthew, the disciples of John the Baptist weren't very joyful because they were full of doubt.
