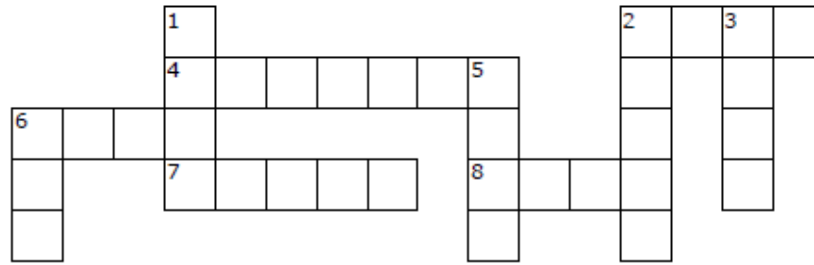


Crossword Puzzle

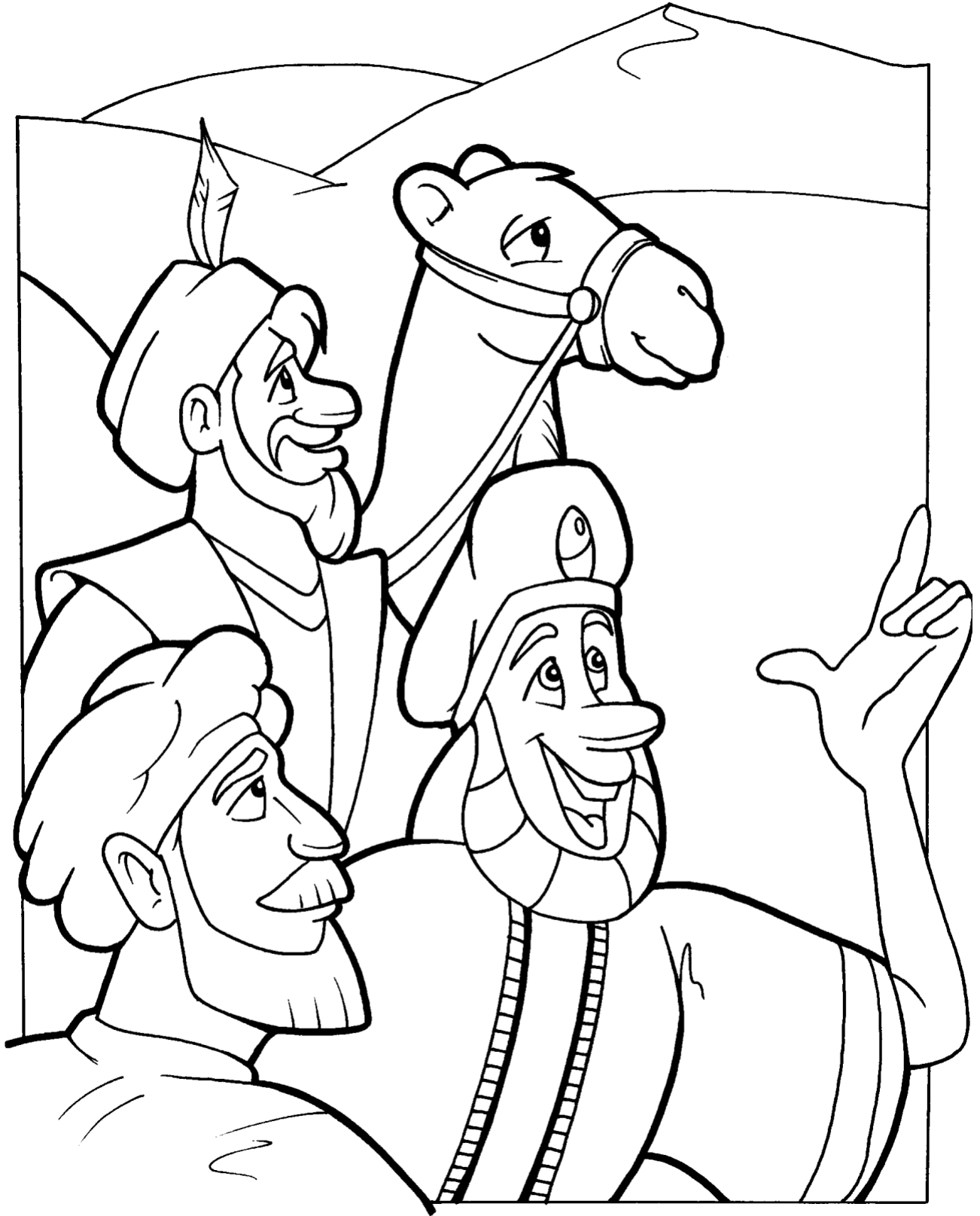
Discussion Question How can we be stars for others?
