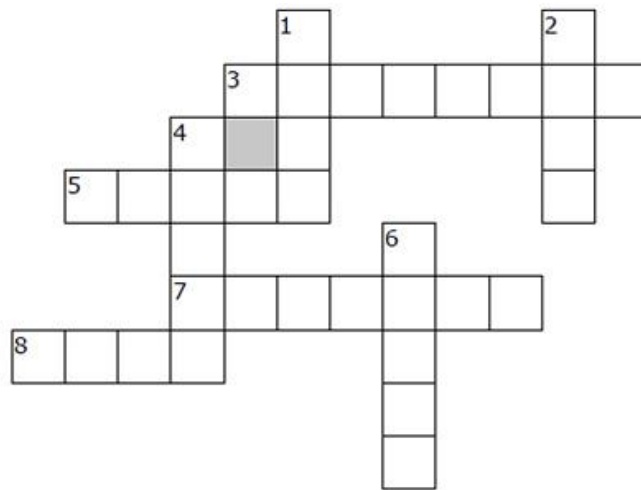


Crossword Puzzle

Transfiguration of Our Lord

Good morning, friends! (Hold up one unlit candle) Can you tell me what this is? What does this candle do? (allow for answers) So, is this candle doing its job right now? Why isn't it lighting up things? How do we make it work? *light candle from altar candle*

In today's gospel message from Matthew, we hear about something other than a candle that lights up. Our story tells us that Jesus goes up a mountain with his disciples to pray. And then, while he's praying, Jesus starts to shine. Did you hear that part? There's this part in the story where it says that Jesus' face "shone like the sun, and his clothes became dazzling white." We even have a special name for this story. We call it the Transfiguration story. "Transfiguration" is a fancy word that means "to be changed." And in a lot of ways, Jesus in today's story and this candle here are a lot alike. On its own, this candle cannot shine. But, with a little help from our other candle, then this candle is changed, or "transfigured," and is able to do what it's supposed to do: It shines a light. The same was true for Jesus. Because Jesus keeps inviting and receiving God's light and love into his life, then Jesus shines very brightly with God's light and love.

Did you know that we can do the same thing? God's love changes us and we carry that love around in our hearts. Let me show you. I want you to smile at our congregation...a great big toothy grin. Did you see their reaction? They smiled back at you, didn't they? Some even giggled. Because of God's love, you have the ability to shine so brightly that it brings light and joy to others. Let's pray together.

Gracious God, Thank you for your son, Jesus who received your light and love and who shares that light and love with us. Help us to share this gift with the rest of the world so that all may know how wonderful you are. Amen.
