


Crossword Puzzle

First Sunday of Advent

Hello friends! Today, I want you to think waaayyyy back to when you started the new school year. I know, it was a long time ago, but I bet you can still remember it. Can you think of the things that you and your family did to get ready to begin the new school year? Maybe you bought school supplies? New notebooks and crayons? Did you have to go online and find your schedule and get set up for virtual learning? Why did you do these things? Yes! So you'd be prepared when the day finally came for you to begin classes. (Thank your grown-ups!!)

In our gospel lesson from Mark, Jesus is doing the same thing...trying to prepare his disciples. He tells them to be awake and alert, to be ready. Nobody likes to be caught off-guard.

Just like we have the first day of school, today is the first day of the Church new year! Today is the first Sunday in Advent. This time of Advent prepares our hearts and minds for hearing stories about Jesus and the lessons that he teaches us. Advent actually means "coming." It's a time of preparation. Jesus says in today's Gospel that he is coming back someday; we just don't know when. In fact, NO ONE but God knows when that will be. But, just like the disciples, we must be ready. We can ready ourselves by reading and talking about the stories that remind us of what Jesus' life and ministry are meant to do, then when we know these stories and listen to Christ's teachings, we'll know how to respond...by sharing that Good News with others.

Loving God, your Son teaches us all that we need to know about living our best lives. Help us to follow his teachings so that we can share his love with others. Amen.
